Inspection Request Priority List

(Ranked in order of Priority)

Appointments can reduce inspector efficiency and are therefore limited to “Special Homeowner Access Coordination” (see note below) and “Special Inspection Required Pre-construction Meetings”. Appointments confirmed between the customer and inspectors are given highest priority.

- 1. Emergency calls.** *(As deemed by the supervisor/manager)*
- 2. Concrete/slab/open-ditch and swimming pool bonding inspection.**
- 3. Any inspection 2 or more days old.**
- 4. Final/TCO inspection when necessary for occupancy [B,E,M,P] and inspection for utility interruptions, change out or relocation [E,M,P].**
- 5. Any inspection 1 day old.** *(Exception: Finals not necessary for occupancy/power)*
- 6. Any other inspection request.**

Note: “Special homeowner access coordination” involves a homeowner who is waiting at home or has taken time off from work in order to provide access to an inspection that would otherwise be inaccessible to the inspector. The special need for access coordination should be communicated by phone directly by the contractor to the inspector. The inspector will confirm appointment with the homeowner (contact # needed). Appointments may be a range/window of time (AM or PM) rather than a specific time.

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
