

MECKLENBURG COUNTY WINDOW STICKER IMPLEMENTATION OUT-OF-COUNTY STICKERS

LANCASTER COUNTY

Mecklenburg County will be phasing in a Window Sticker entry system for the four Full-Service Recycling and Waste Convenience Centers beginning in July 2016. This system is being phased in to allow identification of Mecklenburg County Residents from Non-Mecklenburg County residents, as well as identify commercial customers.

We envision this system will take several months to completely roll-out, and plan to begin the process of sticker sales and distribution in mid-July at our Convenience Centers. Entry stickers are available at all Solid Waste Centers. Stickers will be color coded to allow staff to better identify the origin of waste loads, as well as the different rates that exist between the different categories of waste.

Non-Mecklenburg County residents will have to pay a \$50 fee annually to receive a YELLOW entry sticker. The YELLOW entry sticker will allow an Out-of-County Resident to have the same facility use as a Mecklenburg County resident.

If an Out-of-County resident chooses not to purchase a Sticker, then charges will apply for each visit to dispose of any refuse.

The color coded stickers are being used to allow staff to be able to identify who is allowed to use the facility and stickers should be affixed to the front left of the windshield of the vehicle using the site.

Lancaster County South Carolina residents may pick up a sticker at no charge for a short period of time from Lancaster County. Lancaster County has pre-paid Mecklenburg County for a limited number of entry stickers for its residents. These stickers expire in February 2017. The stickers are available at the Sheriff's Substation in Indian Land: 1821 Sandle Brook Road; Indian Land, SC.

A representative will be at the Lancaster SC location Monday-Friday 8 am to 5 pm.
