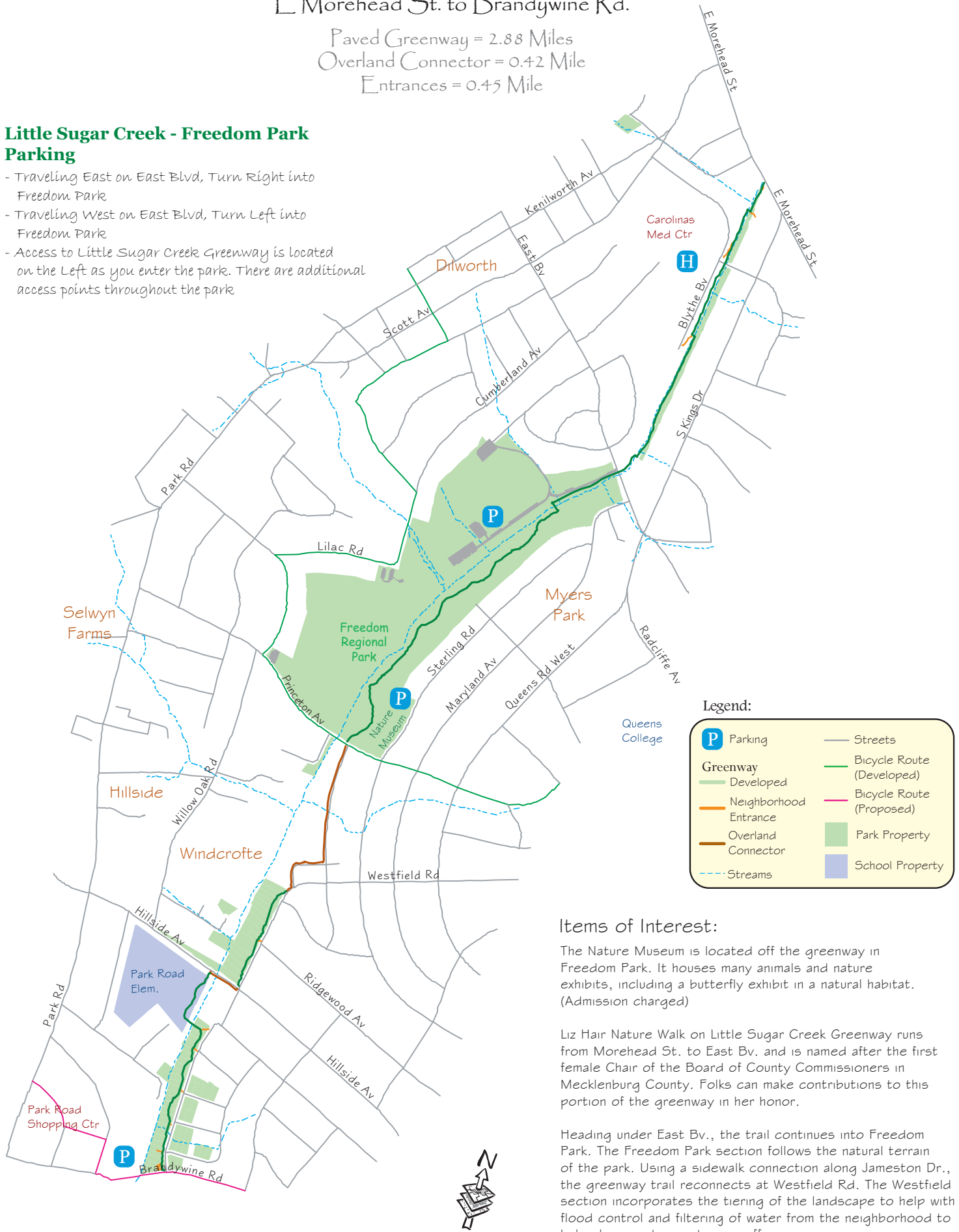


Little Sugar Creek Greenway E Morehead St. to Brandywine Rd.

Paved Greenway = 2.88 Miles
Overland Connector = 0.42 Mile
Entrances = 0.45 Mile

Little Sugar Creek - Freedom Park Parking

- Traveling East on East Blvd, Turn Right into Freedom Park
- Traveling West on East Blvd, Turn Left into Freedom Park
- Access to Little Sugar Creek Greenway is located on the Left as you enter the park. There are additional access points throughout the park

Items of Interest:

The Nature Museum is located off the greenway in Freedom Park. It houses many animals and nature exhibits, including a butterfly exhibit in a natural habitat. (Admission charged)

Liz Hair Nature Walk on Little Sugar Creek Greenway runs from Morehead St. to East Bv. and is named after the first female Chair of the Board of County Commissioners in Mecklenburg County. Folks can make contributions to this portion of the greenway in her honor.

Heading under East Bv., the trail continues into Freedom Park. The Freedom Park section follows the natural terrain of the park. Using a sidewalk connection along Jameston Dr., the greenway trail reconnects at Westfield Rd. The Westfield section incorporates the tiering of the landscape to help with flood control and filtering of water from the neighborhood to help cleanse stormwater run off.
